

Sydney's Motorways

Before you visit Sydney go to www.sydney-motorways.com

This is the official Roads & Traffic Authority's web site with a complete guide to using Sydney's motorway network. You can calculate the cost of your trip, check traffic conditions via live web cam, view detailed interchange maps and find out about electronic tags and passes. But if you use a toll road without a tag or pass **DON'T PANIC!** You must pay the toll within 48 hours. There are signs on every motorway with the number to contact. Fines apply for non-payment.

How to pay Sydney's motorway tolls

All Sydney motorways are toll roads. Some accept cash for toll payment, while others are fully electronic. If you don't have a tag, you will need a pass to use a fully electronic motorway. (Extracted from information provided by RTA)

If you visit Sydney for more than two weeks, we recommend:

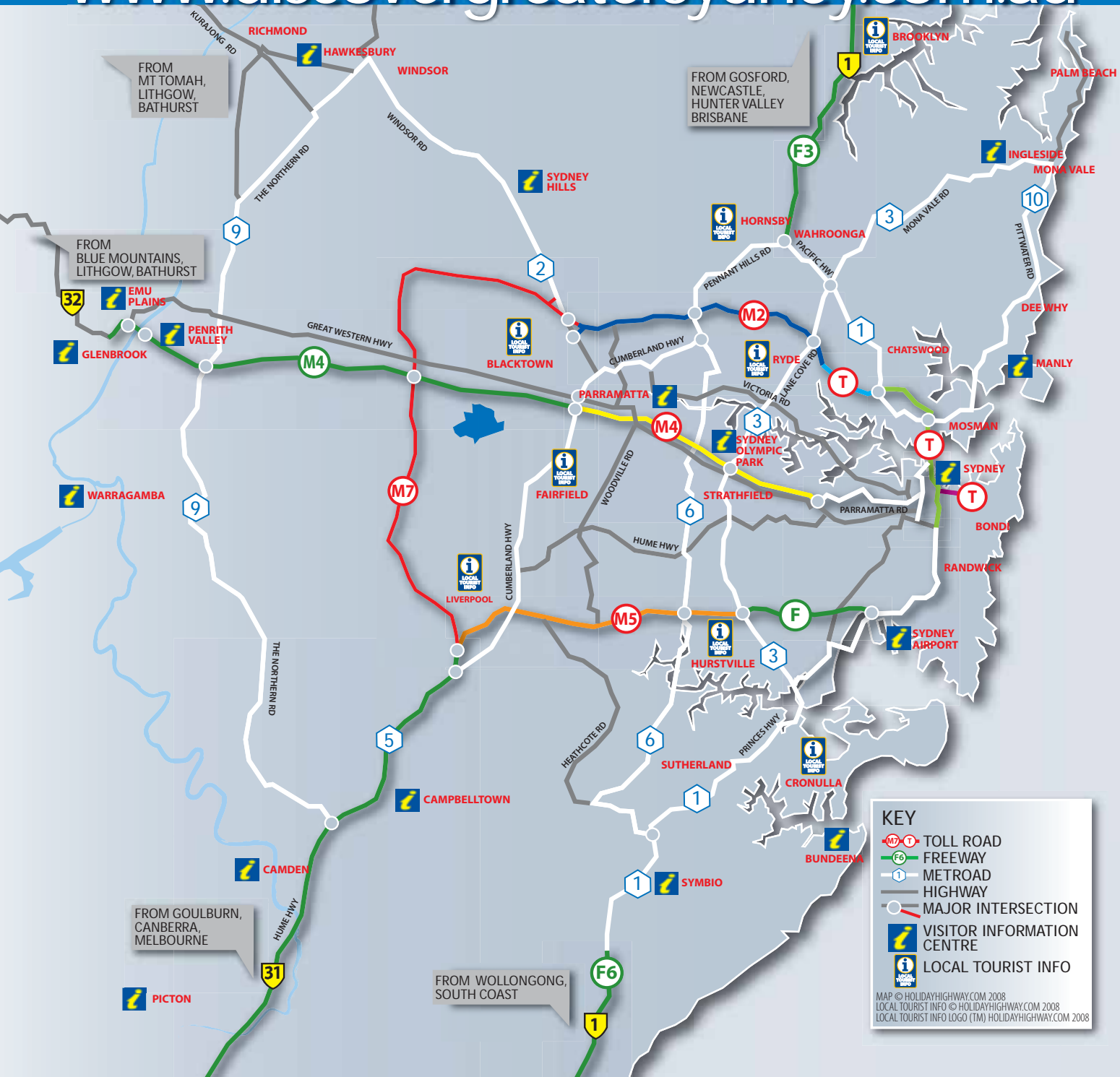
- > Visiting www.sydney-motorways.com
- > Using E-Toll tags that are available from RTA and can be used on all motorways in Australia.
- > Look at using the alternative non-toll routes to every motorway. Use the maps on pages 48 and 49 to find an alternative route. Slower and more difficult to use, but free.
- > We recommend you purchase a Sydway Greater Sydney Street Directory, available at newsagents if you are visiting Sydney regularly or for extended times.
