Holiday on the Harbour

The most affordable way to explore Sydney Harbour is on one of Sydney's famous ferries. Great for getting around the harbour and getting there on the ferry is half the fun! They all leave from Circular Quay.

Some favourite harbour trips experienced by Sydneysiders for generations include:

- > Manly Ferry. Half-hour trip passes many of Sydney's famous harbour landmarks and crosses Sydney Heads.
- > Watsons Bay via Garden Island, Darling Point, Double Bay and Rose Bay. Stay for fish and chips and a stroll around South Head.
- > Special all-inclusive passes to Taronga Zoo.

> RiverCat along the scenic Parramatta River to historic Parramatta, Sydney's second major CBD.

Harbour Cruises. Harbour cruise companies such as Captain Cook, Vagabond and Matilda Cruises all leave from Circular Quay. There are day and night, morning and afternoon, lunch and dinner cruises. Or try Captain Cook Cruises' Weekend Explorer including 2 nights accommodation.
